COVID NEXT STEPS

HOW TO GET YOUR 2nd BOOSTER...

Go to our Ward 4 District-operated COVID Center at 4704 13th Street, NW, inside the Peoples Congregational United Church of Christ. Every day except Sunday, the Center provides one-stop access to free vaccinations, boosters, take-home rapid antigen tests, PCR tests, and KN95 masks. No appointment is necessary and there is plenty of parking. ERCV members and friends have been very pleased with both the Covid Center and the vaccinations at-home program.

Tax Day is April 18, 2022



If you are unable to file your tax return by this year's April 18 deadline, you can request an automatic six-month extension. An extension allows for extra time to gather, prepare, and file paperwork with the IRS; however, taxpayers should be aware that **a request for an extension provides extra time to** *file* **a tax return, but not extra time to** *pay* **any taxes owed**. Payments are still due by the original deadline. Taxpayers should file even if they can't pay the full amount. Estimating and paying any owed taxes by the regular deadline avoids possible penalties. Possible property tax or rent rebates

Homeowner or Renter Households including someone 70 or older with Adjusted Gross Income less than \$76,000 are eligible for up to \$1,225 rebates of property taxes or rent from DC. File a stand-alone Schedule H (or include in your DC income tax return) at <u>MyTaxDC</u>.
